Admission Requirements

- 1. A bachelor's degree with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 (on a four-point scale)
- Applicants who do not meet the requirement may be admitted to the program with the prospect of being granted full-time status if they can maintain a GPA of 3.0 upon completion of 12 credits.
- 3. A functional command of spoken English and an accepted written English test score on one of the following tests:

TOEFL: score of 500 (or 190 CBT)
IELTS: score in the 5.5 bandwidth

Students without a previous degree in Educational Administration are required to take two Foundation Courses and a 135-hour practicum in an educational setting.


