- Applicants who do not meet the requirement may be admitted to the program but must maintain a GPA of 3.0 upon completion of 12 credits.
- Applicants must achieve the **minimum** score on any one of the following English proficiency tests:

-TOEFL: 500

- IELTS: 5.5 band score
