As an Air Traffic Controller, you make the call. A controller directs a plane to ensure it is safe in crucial situations on and above land. This course focuses on skills, knowledge, resourcefulness, and decision-making ability needed to successfully guide airplanes through all stages of a flight. Students get their hands on equipment used in these situations. Career advancement within the airline industry is also addressed. What You Will Learn

The program has been designed to match the International Civil Aviation Organization's standards of aviation education with the aim of producing highly qualified graduates that meet the demands of the air traffic control industry.

Numerous field trips to airports and aviation institutes enable students to study and observe real-world air traffic management operations.
